- 4** Woodside / Goostrey 3.5 miles
- 5** Twemlow / Kermincham / Swettenham 6.25 miles
- 6** Link between Swettenham and Brereton Heath 1.5 miles

Distance from Holmes Chapel to Jodrell Bank 4.5 miles
